


## Instructions for Checking Turnitin Feedback


1. Find your assignment where your professor placed it (usually in “modules”). You can also find your assignments from “grades”.
2. Once you have found the location of your assignment, click on the title of the assignment, which will launch the assignment inbox page, as shown below:
