Persistence: First-year Fall to Spring enrollment

Why do faculty matter?



From the research:

- First and consistent social interaction
- Academic integration is half of the retention picture
- Provide a "fit" barometer

- Strong's Concordance for "...and keep you"
- Šāmar (shaw-mar')
- To keep, preserve, protect

Roles Faculty Play



Individual Champion

Cares deeply about retention, and takes a one-on-few personal approach.



Reluctant Traveler

Has an understanding that it matters, but is at the very bottom of the to do list.



Somewhat Skeptic

Don't have a lot of faith in the top-down interventions proposed/implemented.
