ACU Dallas provides academic programs for adult learners. From time to time, the University identifies programs that are currently offered as residential programs on the ACU Abilene campus that would also work well for online delivery. In such cases, the Dallas campus works cooperatively with the Abilene department or program leadership to obtain program learning outcomes and student learning outcomes for each course and then to deliver the faculty-approved curriculum through a new modality.

Please review the Child Life Track to the B.S. in Child and Family Services program to approve for delivery through the Dallas campus. ACU Dallas will administer and fund the track, which will be overseen by a credentialed Program Director who reports to the Dean of CGPS or designee.
