Per our conversation, my understanding is below. I'm copying Eric for his thoughts.

Eric, does this match your understanding?

In regard to the section of the new course application pasted below, my understanding of these two questions is that they refer whether a student can repeat the course earning additional credit each subsequent semester, and how many times the student can enroll in and earn additional credit for the course. For example, if a 3-hour course is *repeatable* up to 3 times, the student could earn 9 hours of credit with the same course number over three semesters. This question is *not* referring to students being allowed to repeat the course for a grade that would replace the previously earned grade.

Susan's explanation is accurate - #9 is asking about whether the course can be taken more than once for credit, and #10 is asking the maximum number of times that it may be taken for credit. Item #11 actually asks about the maximum number of hours of credit a student can count for the course. Since there is continued confusion and there is, in effect, a double meaning for the term repeatable in the context of courses, I'd like to visit with Susan about a potential rewording to help improve the clarity of those items.
