Proposed Change: Replace the Context section (Con. Ed. Sequence) within the Major Requirements section with the proposed Ministry Core

Rationale:

Several factors make this proposal a necessary component of our wider curriculum revisions. First, as the GST integrates Contextual Education throughout the curriculum there becomes less need for a separate and discrete block of contextual education courses. Secondly, the Contextual Education Sequence that resulted from the GST's last curriculum revision was heavily influenced by the field of congregational studies. This was an important development that addressed lacunae in the previous BIBM curriculum. Yet the needs of ministers, and the larger field of Practical Theology, have moved from that congregational studies orientation. Thus, the new BIBM curriculum has a new set of lacunae which it seeks to address; both with respect to content and the "typical" GST student within our programs.
