Course Number: SOCW 635 Social & Racial Justice in Anti-Oppression Practice **or Degree Plan(s):**

Rationale: We originally revamped this course to align with CSWE wording on ADEI in curriculum. To minimize controversial or contentious complaints about the course information publicly available in the ACU catalog, we are adjusting the title and catalog description to align more with the ACU Mission and Strategic Plan. This is consistent with what other public and private MSSW programs are doing throughout the state of Texas.

New Course Title: SOCW 635 Human Diversity, Dignity, and Justice

Current Catalog Description: Students will understand the intersection between human rights, advocacy, and anti-oppression practice. This course investigates how identity development influences social justice efforts and how power and privilege promulgate systemic and structural oppression for racialized and marginalized populations. The historical context of discrimination and oppression is also examined.

New Catalog Description: Students will examine the intersection of human diversity, inherent dignity, and the pursuit of justice. Students explore how identity development and structural factors can impact the well-being of marginalized populations. This course equips students to respond to diverse cultures and customs with cultural humility.

³ For undergraduate majors, a minimum of 30 hours is required. These programs must have a minimum of 6 elective hours, unless the requirements of external accrediting bodies make it impossible. Master's programs

must include a minimum of 30 hours, and doctoral programs must include a minimum of 30 hours beyond the master's.

⁴ When a department/school or dean proposes closing a program, approval routing follows the typical process beginning with the department/school. An administrative proposal by the provost or senior vice president for academic affairs would follow the "provost-proposed" routing on the chart.

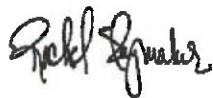
