1. The instructor is enthusiastic about the course.

3. The instructor demonstrates mastery of the subject matter.
4. The instructor uses enough variety in class.
5. The instructor maintains a well-paced, but flexible, course schedule and sets realistic deadlines.
6. The instructor presents lectures that are interesting and informative.
