Rationale: This course was created for the expressed purpose of providing content related to life-span human development in order to satisfy the Family Studies Program certification requirements of the National Council on Family Relations (NCFR). The course is primarily populated by Family Studies majors; for example, in Fall 2011 there were 48 students enrolled in the class of which 39 were FAM majors. The FAM and GERO programs have shared a departmental affiliation for the past 15 years; however, with the realignment of academic programs the two will be in different colleges in the future. As such, it is desirable to establish a FAM prefix for the course as it is required of all FAM majors in the Department of Marriage and Family Studies and in order to meet the certification requirements of NCFR.
