# Proposal for New Courses in Entrepreneurship and Philanthropy Concentration

In spring 2012, we received approval for a new concentration in entrepreneurship and philanthropy. This new concentration is available to students of any business major or minor, assuming that prerequisites are satisfied. We are now proposing the following changes:

## 1. Add three new courses to the existing EP concentration.

## 2. Update the Business Foundations portion of all COBA degree plans

The proposed change would add MGMT 419: Global Entrepreneur as an option to satisfy the three credit hour requirement currently met by taking MGMT 419, MKTG 419, or FIN 419. The updated Business Foundations portion of all COBA degree plans (ACCT, FIN, MGMT, MKTG, and IS) would be as follows:

- MGMT 330 Management and Organizational Behavior 3 hours
- MGMT 331 Operations Management 3 hours
- MGMT 439 Strategic Management (writing-intensive course) 3 hours
- MKTG 320 Principles of Marketing 3 hours
- Choose one: BUSA 419, FIN 419, MKTG 419, **MGMT 419** 3 hours<sup>2</sup>

### Mathematics

- Choose one: MATH 130, 131, 185, or 186 (3 hours)<sup>1</sup>
