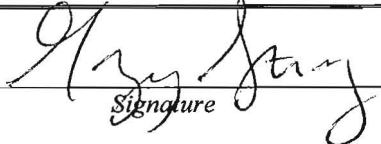

Rationale for adding BIBP 486 – Ethics to the menu of options for the Sociology minor

With the closure of SOCI 460 – Social Ethics in the spring of 2012 BIBP 486 was added to the Sociology major but not in the minor. A course in ethics is important in a discipline like Sociology where we emphasize social justice, ethical research methods, and the role of ethics in society.
