We currently don't have the faculty to support two art education courses aimed specifically at our Art Education majors. I believe two courses is a luxury for this degree that we can't continue to support with our current numbers. We have 3-4 active majors in this degree and approximately 180 majors in our department.

Our effort here is to combine the content from "ART 287 Art for Elementary Teachers" and "ART 488 Art Education: Secondary" into one course. This is what we are requesting:

- 1) "ART 488 Art Education: Secondary" be closed and removed from the catalog and the BFA All-level Teaching degree plan.
- 2) In place of ART 488 students would be required to take a 200-499 level studio elective.
- 3) ART 287's name be changed from "Art for Elementary Teachers" to "Art Education Methods: All-Levels".
- 4) ART 287's course description be changed (see attached).

This course will be taught for the first time in the Fall of 2015. Because the content of ART 287 will change beyond 20% our plan is to present new competencies and measures to academic council in the Fall of 2014.

Because of many improvements in the education curriculum in recent years I don't believe this change will negatively impact student's education. I actually believe an additional studio class will be advantageous to students wanting to teach art. This course will be taught once every other year.
