Changes to Major Requirements:

1. ENG 331 Narrative for Film or ENGL 332 Intro to Film - Supplements ENG 331 with new course offered by English Department.
2. JMC 488 Comm Law or BLAW 363 Bus Law or PHIL 486 Ethics - Supplements JMC 488 to provide appropriate alternatives for Game Development & Digital Design concentrations. (See #9 below.)
3. Move CS 116 Scripting II or CS 130 Programming II to Game Development concentration - other concentrations did not need this much programming.

Changes to Major Selection or Concentration:

4. Add the 3 hours removed from major requirements (see #3) to increase the major selection or concentration to 18 hours.
5. Add the note requiring at least 9 advanced hours to each of the concentrations to ensure students meet the university advanced hours requirement.

Digital Design Concentration (DD): [list first in catalog to alphabetize the concentrations]

6. Replace DET 350 with "Any DET electives" to make all DET electives available.
7. Expand the Art selections with the following courses that support the growing 3D emphasis in game and animation: ART 106 Three-Dimensional Design; ART 111 Basic Drawing; ART 112 Figure Drawing; ART 317 Intro to Illustration; and ART 318 Digital Illustration.

Film & Media Production Concentration (FMP):

8. Replace DET 350 with "Any DET electives" to make all DET electives available.
9. Based on JMC input, FMP students must take JMC 488 Comm Law. Hours may count in major requirements above.
10. Based on JMC input, the following note is added to JMC 361, which mirrors the note in the Film minor on JMC courses: Note: DET majors may take any required JMC classes without meeting the prerequisite of JMC 100 (Media Issues). Junior standing is required to take JMC courses at the 300 level or above. Instructor approval required for JMC 361 (Advanced Video Production) if students do not meet JMC 261 (Broadcast Production) prerequisite.
11. Add ENGL 321, 332, and 333 to the list of film-related English courses in this menu.

Game Development (GD): [this concentration now has 6 required hours and 12 elective hours]

12. Add "Any DET electives" to make all DET electives available. (Note that DET 350 is still required in this concentration, and it still may be taken twice for credit.)

Change Support Area:

13. Modify description to: An approved 6 course area of emphasis (at least 6 advanced hours), which may be used toward a minor. This addresses Registrar input about Degree Works concerns about old wording and Provost office concerns about satisfying university advanced hours requirement.
