

University Undergraduate Academic Council May 5, 2016, Electronic Vote

Agenda items were posted to the UUAC blog on May 2 and considered by council electronically as a supplemental meeting at the end of the semester.

Dr. Bacon and Dr. Crisp met to pull together a revised version of the DET program revision and arrived at a temporary solution that will be viable for the 2016-17 academic year. They “agreed that this is a one-year fix for the Film & Production emphasis in order for the changes to move forward. I realize the catalog will not indicate it’s a one-year fix. But in the fall, the DET/JMC faculty will need to re-visit this plan and consider capacity issues in JMC classes for the future.”

To help facilitate improved inter-departmental communication in the future for situations similar to this that arise, Dr. Bacon suggested that we craft a clearer procedure to assure that the approval and signature of affected departments becomes a mandatory requirement for any proposals that affect enrollment in those departments’ courses at our first meeting in the fall.

Sam Stewart made a motion to approve the DET revision of major. Greg Powell seconded. All in favor. Motion passes.

- IV. Remove CHEM 114 from Nursing Degree Plan Menu

Several council members raised concerns about removing the Chemistry option from the Nursing menu. Since the discussion was being held electronically via the blog, members were unable to pose their questions directly to Dr. Hammack to receive clarification on the issue. Therefore, Sam Stewart made a motion to table the discussion until the fall when Nursing could send a representative to the UUAC meeting and allow for a fuller discussion.

Sam Stewart made a motion to table the CHEM 114 Nursing Proposal. Greg Powell seconded. All in favor. Motion passes.
