V. KGEN Track – Remove HED 112

S. Jones – Dickie Hill is retiring, and he teaches two sections of this course every semester. With him gone, we only have staff to teach one section. It's a 100-level course, and students often get more in-depth material later on with the upper-level courses. S. Lewis – Is this a course needed by PT or OT programs? S. Jones – No. S. Lewis – Does Hope know about this change? S. Jones – No, but we can make her aware. It is not needed for her program requirements.

S. Jones – Can we make these changes retroactive? Let's go back two catalog years.

S. Lewis – Do you feel there is a hole you will need to plug? S. Jones – We are developing a course for the PT and OT majors that will be a good addition. The other programs, I don't think there will be a push to add any new courses.

G. Powell – What does HED stand for? S. Jones – Health Education. G. Powell – Will upper-division courses continue to be offered without Dickie? S. Jones – Probably not. Most of those courses haven't made in several years.
