We are requesting that FAM 265 be dropped from the Child and Services Degree Plan after Fall 2018, and replace it with FAM 275 (starting Fall 2018) and FAM 280 (starting Spring 2019). Requiring 2 child development courses (FAM 275 & FAM 280) is based on 2019 academic requirements by the Association of Child Life Professionals (ACLP). Students majoring in Child and Family Services who are pursuing a career as a Child Life Specialist, will be required to take 2 child development courses. As our department works to meet the 2019 undergraduate requirements and plans to build a Masters in Child Life, it is necessary to expand our child development course offerings. Thus, dropping FAM 265 and replacing it with FAM 275 and FAM 280 will satisfy this requirement by ACLP and will continue to fulfill the child development course requirements for the degree in Child and Family Services.

Courses or degrees offered only to students seeking teacher certification must go through the Teacher Education Council. All undergraduate changes must go before the UUAC. All graduate degree plan changes must go through the Graduate Council.

⁴ A minimum of 30 hours is required for a major. A maximum is specified for each degree (e.g., BA, BS). The university minimum for elective hours is 6, unless the requirements of external accrediting bodies make it impossible.

⁵ Program or course changes that apply to any major that includes Teacher Certification will be reviewed by the college, the Teacher Education Council (TEC), and then the UUAC.

⁶ Courses that satisfy ACU's University Requirements (General Education) will normally have lower-level numbering, be free of prerequisites and co-requisites, appeal to more than one or two majors, and "not narrowly focus on those skills, techniques, and procedures specific to a particular occupation or profession" (SACS 2.7.3). Departments may request exceptions to the first three criteria.

⁷ The UUAC approved the clarification that "general requirements for graduation" means the enumerated items in the "General Requirements for Bachelor's Degrees" section of the catalog.
