The original proposal included PSYC 120 Introduction to Psychology. We wanted to require that the course taken to fulfill this requirement be taken in residence, avoiding dual credit. We found out that there is no way to manage that in Banner. Students could potentially (and often do) take Intro to Psych while in high school. We do not want a course taken while in high school to be considered part of their professional education sequence. Therefore, we eliminated PSYC 120 from the menu and added PSYC 241.
