

Department of Language and Literature: Curricular Changes – 02/17/2020

After a careful review of the English curriculum, the faculty has approved and proposed the following changes:

- **English Major:** Reduce the number of menus in our English BA from 12 to three.
- **English Minor:** Revise to eliminate freshman composition, require six hours of 200-level courses and 12 hours of 300-400-level majors.
- **French Minor:** close the minor while retaining French course offerings
- Revise course titles, descriptions, and content for the following English classes:
 - ENGL 112
 - ENGL 301
- Revise course descriptions for the following English classes to represent multicultural voices currently included in these courses:
 - ENGL 262 America Literature before 1900
 - ENGL 263 American Literature after 1900
 - ENGL 362 American Literature before 1860
 - ENGL 363 American Literature after 1860
 - ENGL 499 World Literature – Capstone
- Propose new sophomore literature courses
 - ENGL 235: German Literature in Translation
 - ENGL 271: Latino American Literature – Pre-Colonial Period to Twenty-First Century Latino writers:
 - ENGL 275: Magical Realist Literature
- Propose new experiential learning majors class
 - ENGL 385: Environmental Literature
