The Global Healthcare course BIOL/CHEM/CSD/NURS 308 has been an approved elective course and cultural competency course. It is not *required* for any major, but is offered as an elective option of particular interest to students on pre-health professions and nursing career tracks regardless of major. To distinguish the course from content courses in the Biology, Chemistry and Biochemistry, and Communication Science and Disorders Departments we are requesting a change of prefix to the new prefix PHP that is being used to distinguish courses taught for the Pre-Health Professions student population. (Three seminar courses and a special topics course are in process of application for approval that will also carry the PHP prefix as part of the development of the Center for Pre-Health Professions.) Again, we hope that this will help students identify the Pre-Health Professions specific coursework and limit confusion with Biology, Chemistry and Biochemistry, and Communication Science and Disorders Department content courses. The Nursing College has elected to continue to use the NURS prefix for the sections of the course taught to a primarily Pre-nursing population.

BIOL/CHEM/CSD/NURS 308 has not been taught since the summer of 2018 in Leipzig and the summer of 2019 in Montevideo. We would like to begin using the new prefix for the course that should be taught this summer in both Leipzig (PHP308) and Montevideo (NURS308).
