Re: General education proposal progress

The University General Education Council began discussing the General Education Revision Proposal at its meeting Sept. 22 and continued through the Oct. 13 and Oct. 27 meetings. Minutes of those discussions are available on the [UGEC blog](#), and these may provide insight on how the council reached its conclusions.

UGEC has discussed the requirements for bachelor's degrees and approved the proposal as amended through discussion by the council. Their revision supersedes the original version of the proposal. UGEC will continue to discuss the associate's degree requirements, explication of student learning outcomes, and requirements for individual ACU degrees.

In order to have time for robust discussion at the UUAC council, we will begin discussing the bachelor's degree requirements and general aspects of the proposal. We will not conduct a vote on any aspects of the proposal at the Nov. 3 meeting but will provide valuable time for orientation to the proposal and discussion of it.
