Currently, DBMM majors are not required to take any ethics or moral reasoning course. The addition of BIBT 470 would rectify this deficiency.

We will reduce the total number of elective hours for all BBMN and BMV degree plans by three and utilize those hours for the BIBT 470 requirement, thereby maintaining the same total number of hours for all degree plans.
