Master's programs must include a minimum of 30 hours, and doctoral programs must include a minimum of 30 hours beyond the master's.

⁴ When a department/school or dean proposes closing a program, approval routing follows the typical process beginning with the department/school. An administrative proposal by the provost or senior vice president for academic affairs would follow the "provost-proposed" routing on the chart.

Hi Sheila,

Thank you for giving us the chance to review your plans. We believe that the following courses should be excluded from your menu to ensure that students get exposure to physics content that is at least tangentially relevant.

We suggest omitting PHYS 101, PHYS 203 and PHYS 204, PHYS 378, PHYS 379, PHYS 401.

These classes are geared toward teachers, very low level and not generally helpful for medical work in the case of astronomy, and in the case of 378 and 379 are more social science related.
