With the retirement of the faculty member who has historically taught ECON 438: International Poverty and Development, we are working to find a way to continue to teach this valuable course. We do not currently have any faculty members who are credentialed to teach this course as an ECON class who have room in their schedule (or the interest) to teach this class.

We propose changing the course prefix to BUSA so that this class can be taught by faculty in the management sciences department as well as faculty from the finance department. (The finance department currently has two open positions. It's possible that one of the new hires would have an interest in this topic, and we want to facilitate that option.) While the specifics of the course material would reflect the training and interest of the faculty member, we would have a consistent catalog description and learning objectives regardless of who is teaching the class.

There will be no change in the learning objectives.

The catalog description, however, would be modified slightly to include the impact of business on both poverty and development. The addition to the description is denoted with italics.

New description: Global poverty and development, including challenges facing economically poor countries and individuals, material and non-material views of poverty, relief and development paradigms and organizations, assessment and intervention tools used by development agencies, *and the contributory and intervening role of business in poverty and development.*

The current plan is for the course to be taught every third semester, beginning in Fall 2025. (It's currently listed as a Spring course.)

² Any change to a cross-listed course requires the signature of both department chairs or program directors overseeing the course to ensure that the courses stay in sync. This includes courses taught at other campuses (e.g. BIBL 101 and BIBO 101).

³ For undergraduate majors, a minimum of 30 hours is required. These programs must have a minimum of 6 elective hours, unless the requirements of external accrediting bodies make it impossible. Master's programs must include a minimum of 30 hours, and doctoral programs must include a minimum of 30 hours beyond the master's.

⁴ When a department/school or dean proposes closing a program, approval routing follows the typical process beginning with the department/school. An administrative proposal by the provost or senior vice president for academic affairs would follow the “provost-proposed” routing on the chart.
