We are wanting to take several actions with CSO 330 (explanations below):

- Remove cross-listing.
- Change course-title.
- Change pre-reqs.
- Change course number.

CSO 330 Human-Computer Interaction (ACU Online) is currently cross-listed with CS 330 Human Computer Interaction (ACU Abilene). The cross-list is being removed because ACU Abilene is shifting the focus of CS 330 away from being a programming course and the new focus will be more marketing focused. We (ACU Online) want to keep ours as a programming course.

In addition to the cross-list break, we (ACU Online) want to change the title and prerequisites. The new title will be *Interface Design* to differentiate it from the main campus course. Also, we are replacing the current prerequisites (ITC 125 & MKTO 341) with CSO 116 - Applied Programming Using Scripting.

To further differentiate the courses a new course number will be assigned. The new course number will be CSO 335. This number has been approved and assigned by the Registrar.
