The Communication Disorders program is a shared program between Abilene and Dallas campuses. Recently, the Abilene campus made a decision to add co-requisites to some courses, starting with CSD 225, which is crosslisted with CDSO 225. The co-requisite requirement (CSD 226) is an effort to establish a practical learning co-requisite element to the CST 225 course.

Additionally, the Abilene campus made a decision to add an Experiential Learning menu of 3 hours: CSD 353 (only when taken as part of study abroad), CSD 494, IPE 301, IPE 302.

The program in CGPS intends to eventually develop a cross-listed version of CSD 226 and an Experiential Learning Menu. This will, however, require more time and consideration to develop within the online prime course model.

As a result, we will waive the co-requisite requirement for CSDO 225 and the Experiential Learning Menu until such time as a) we hire a new director for the CDSO program, b) the new director is able to review whether and how experiential learning will be accomplished in the online prime course model and the appropriate timelines to establish the same, and c) the new program director has sufficient time to develop the course. A plan for these changes will be completed within one year of the new director's start date.
