This memo will serve as notification that the Master of Education in Instruction and Learning degree has added three program outcomes with accompanying student learning outcomes (see below). Program outcomes do not currently exist for the MEd in IL Program. As a result, this notification is provided to document that outcomes have been added to the existing program.

Program Outcome #1 Leadership: Learners demonstrate effective and inclusive leadership skills.

Student Learning Outcome #1.1: Effective educators and leaders will develop, advocate, and enact a shared mission, vision, and the core values of high-quality education, academic success, and the well-being of each student.
