New Title: Qualitative Analysis

Old Description: Students will explore methodologies that can be used to address research problems of practice. Within specific methodologies, students will learn of specific designs and how to structure research questions that reflect those designs. Students will work to integrate knowledge into decision-making about methodologies and designs within alignment case studies. Prerequisite: [LEAD 701](#), [LEAD 711](#), [LEAD 714](#).

New Description: Students will explore qualitative research designs to analyze and interpret collected qualitative data. Themes and patterns will be identified to produce research findings. Analysis types include content, thematic, narrative, and document, using appropriate tools. Students will use concepts learned in this course to complete dissertations and to drive informed decision-making. Prerequisite: LEAD 784.

New Course Outcomes:

1. Analyze data collected through different types of qualitative research designs.
2. Demonstrate techniques of coding, categorizing, and interpreting qualitative data.
3. Evaluate data to produce meaningful conclusions, research findings, and recommendations.

Prerequisites: Changed as it will be necessary for students to learn the curriculum provided in the Qualitative Method and Designs course prior to the curriculum of the Qualitative Analysis course.

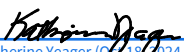
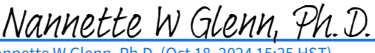
¹ Any change to a cross-listed course requires the signature of both department chairs or program directors overseeing the course to ensure that the courses stay in sync. This includes courses taught at other campuses (e.g. BIBL 101 and BIBO 101).

² For undergraduate majors, a minimum of 30 hours is required. These programs must have a minimum of 6 elective hours, unless the requirements of external accrediting bodies make it impossible. Master's programs must include a minimum of 30 hours, and doctoral programs must include a minimum of 30 hours beyond the master's.

³ When a program director or dean proposes closing a program, approval routing follows the typical process beginning with the program. An administrative proposal by the provost or senior vice president for academic affairs would follow the "provost-proposed" routing on the chart.
