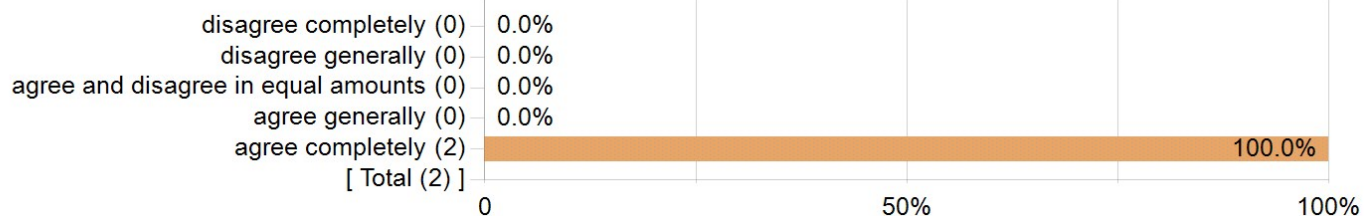

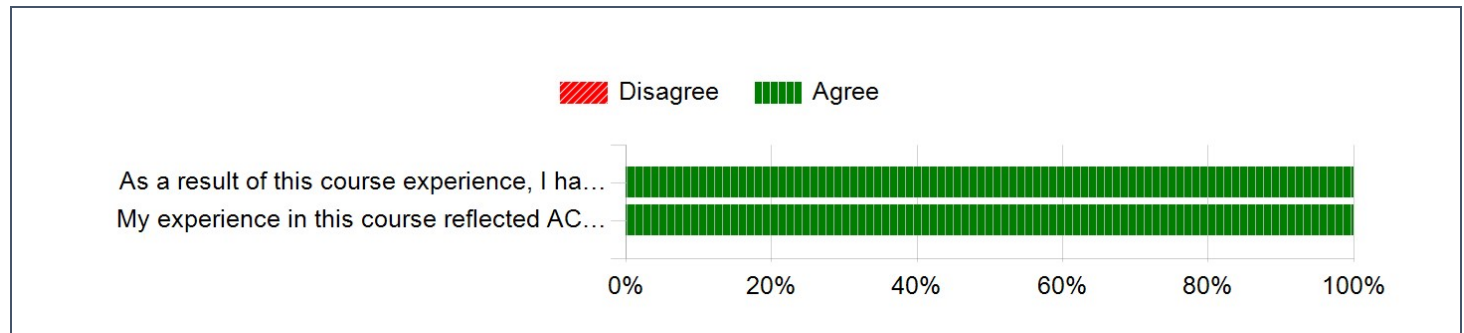

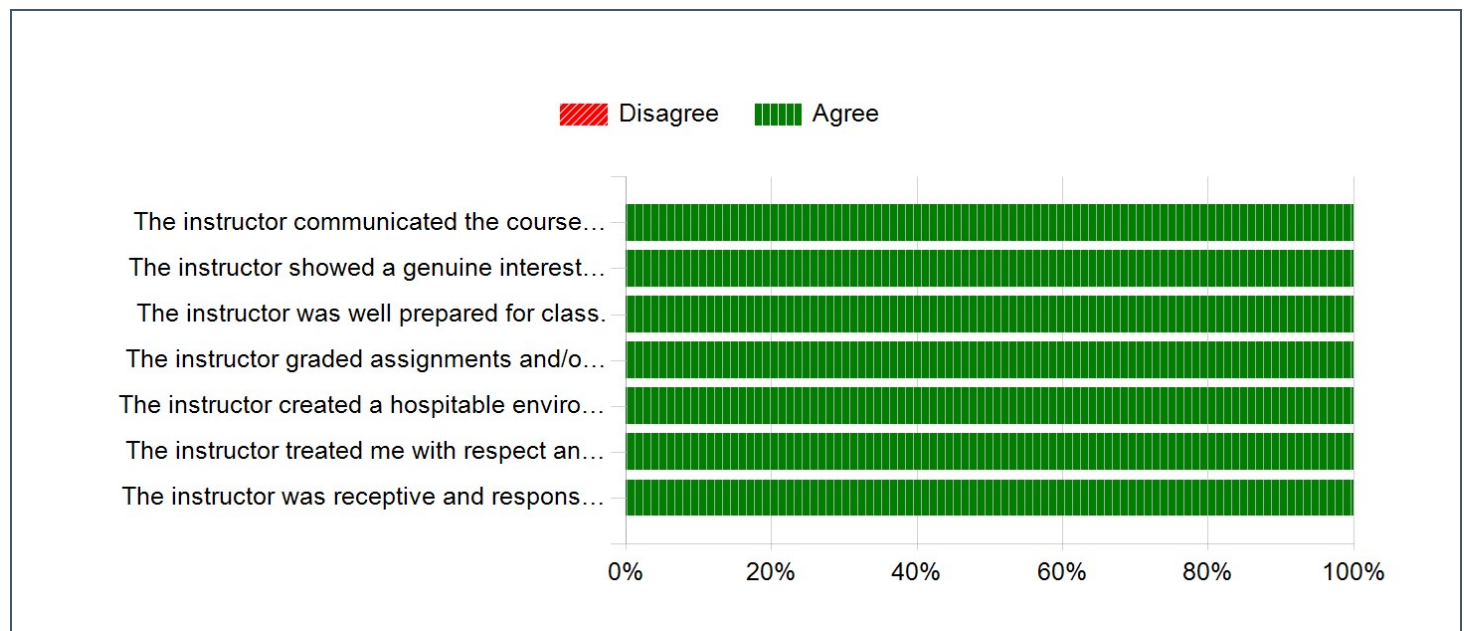
Course Questions: - Aggregate Chart

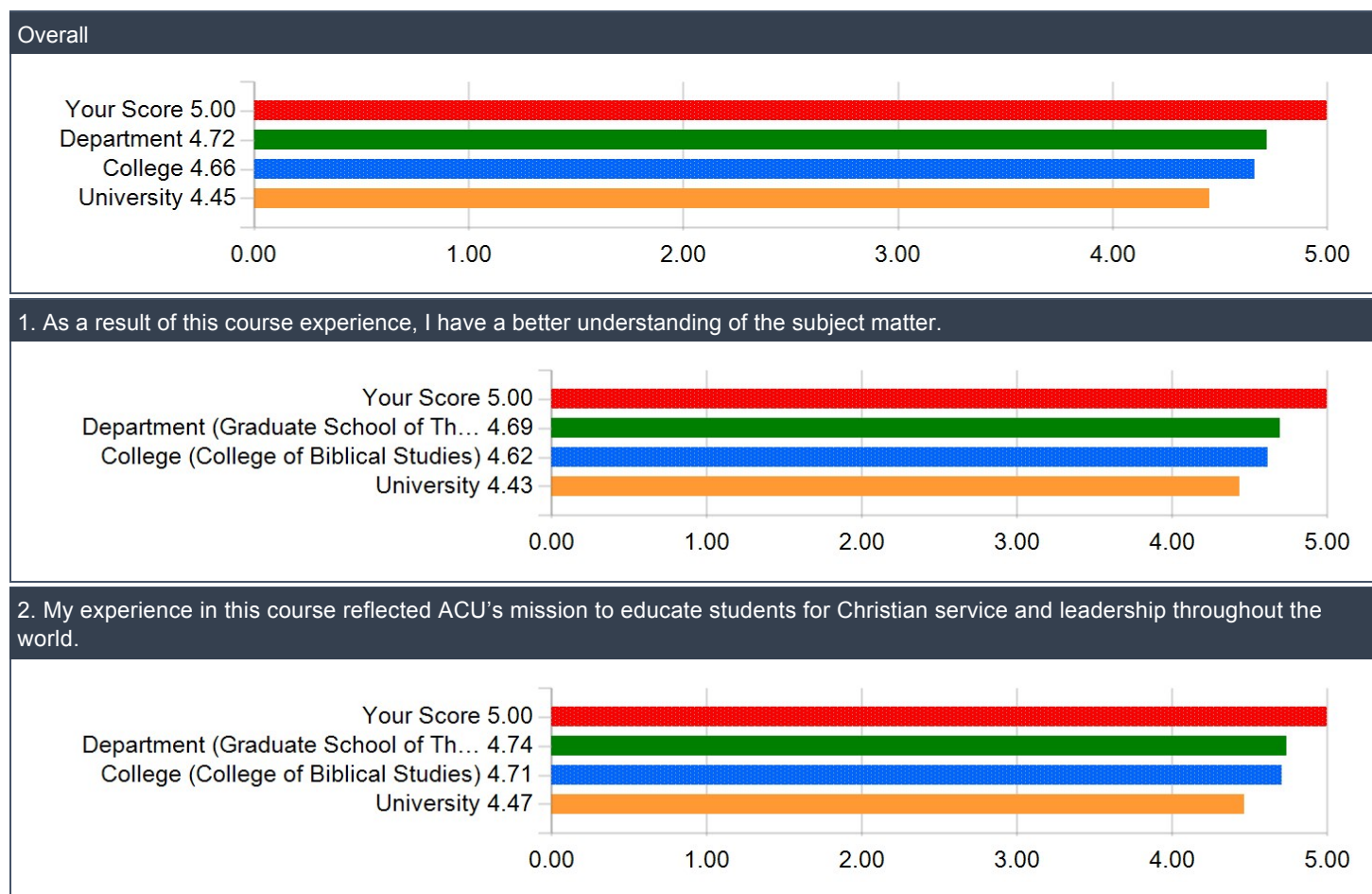

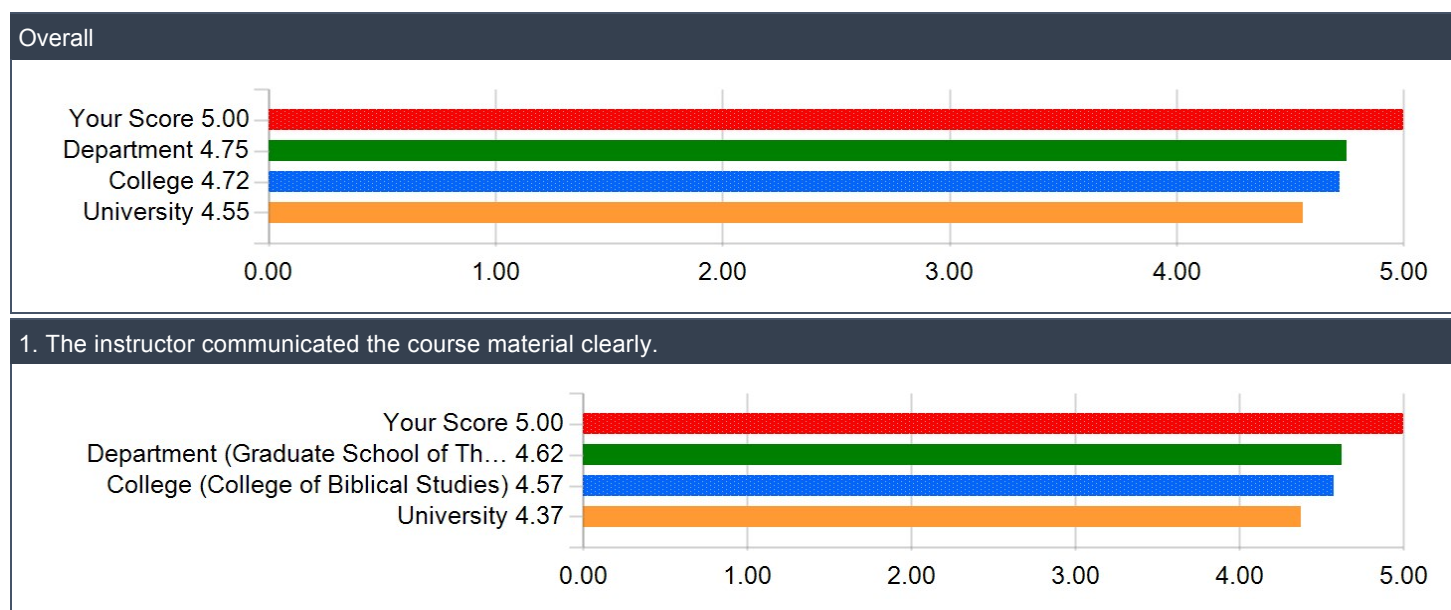

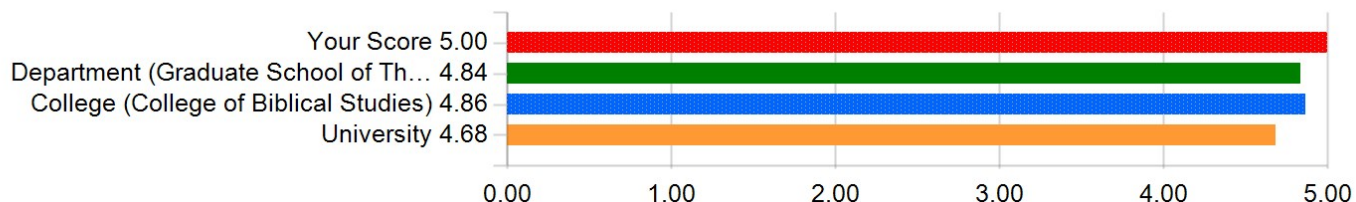
Course Questions: - Comparative Scores



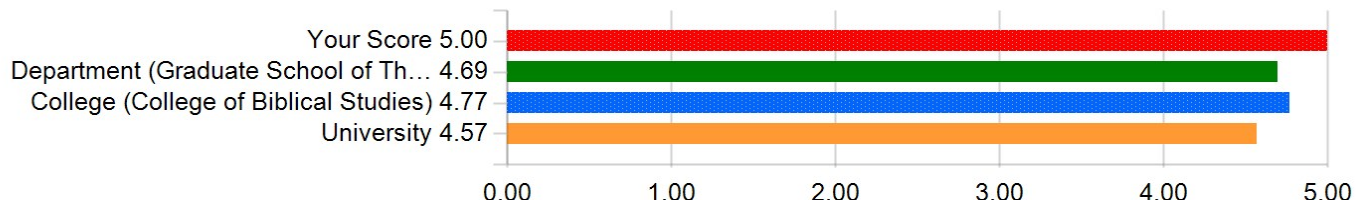
Instructor Questions: - Comparative Scores



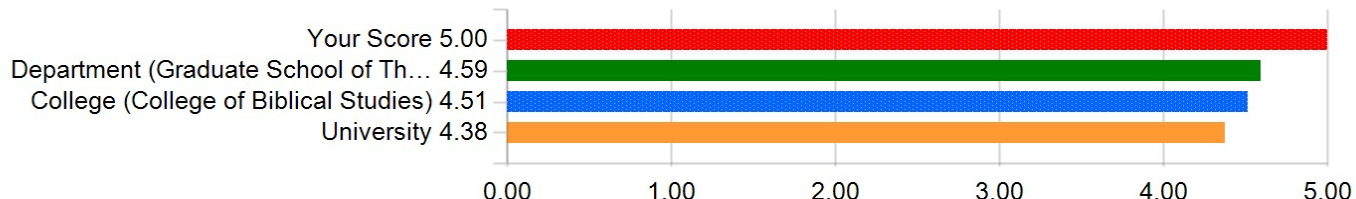

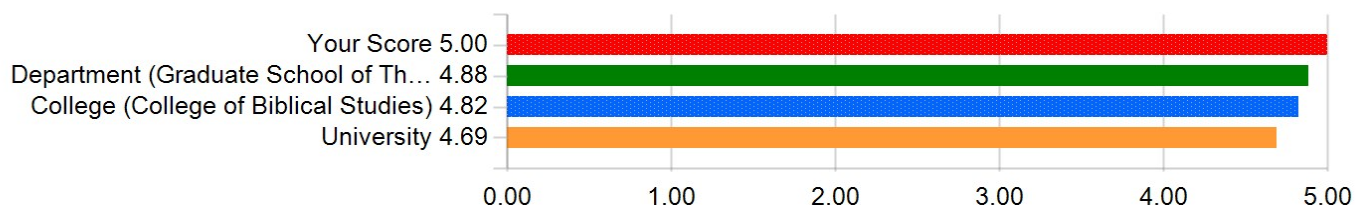

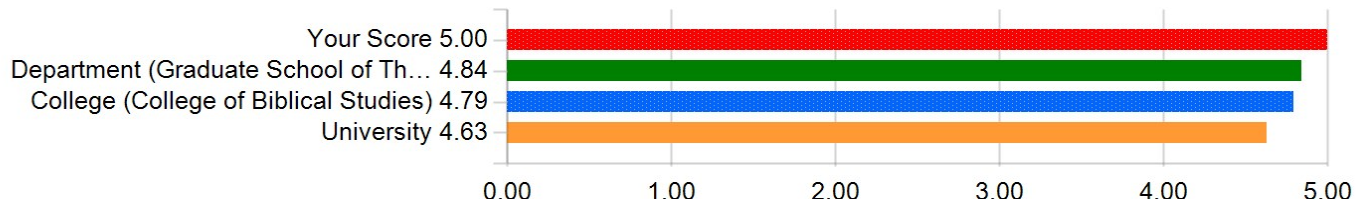

Comments
"Grading" my own translation work was very frustrating at times. We don't know enough yet, especially in the first weeks of the course, to know whether our translations are an acceptable alternative to what is given in the key or not. This is true particularly when translating English to Greek. I eventually gave up trying to analyze my English to Greek work and just focused on the rest of the assignment. I thought it might have been helpful for us to upload scans of our translation work so the instructor could see how we analyzed the text before we arrived at the final translation. Then she would be able to more effectively identify what we do or do not understand.
