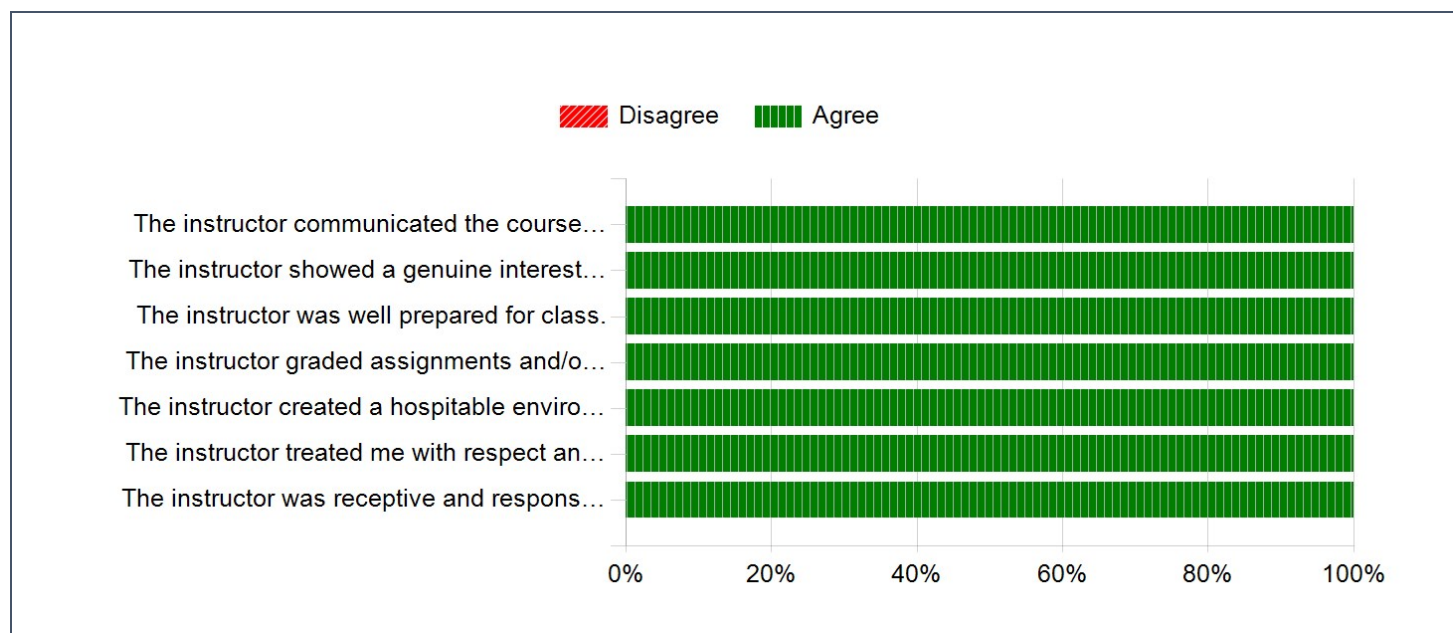

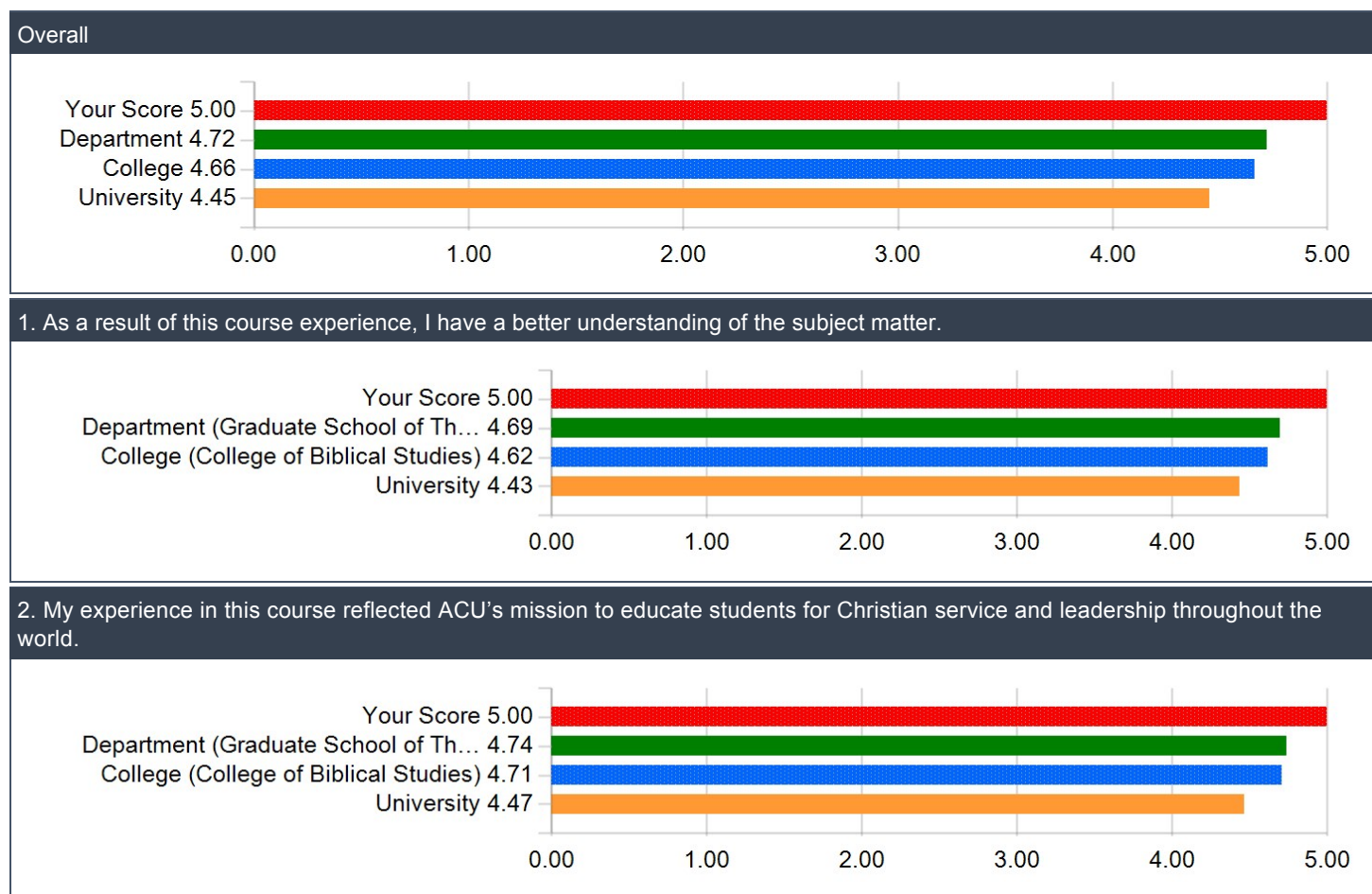

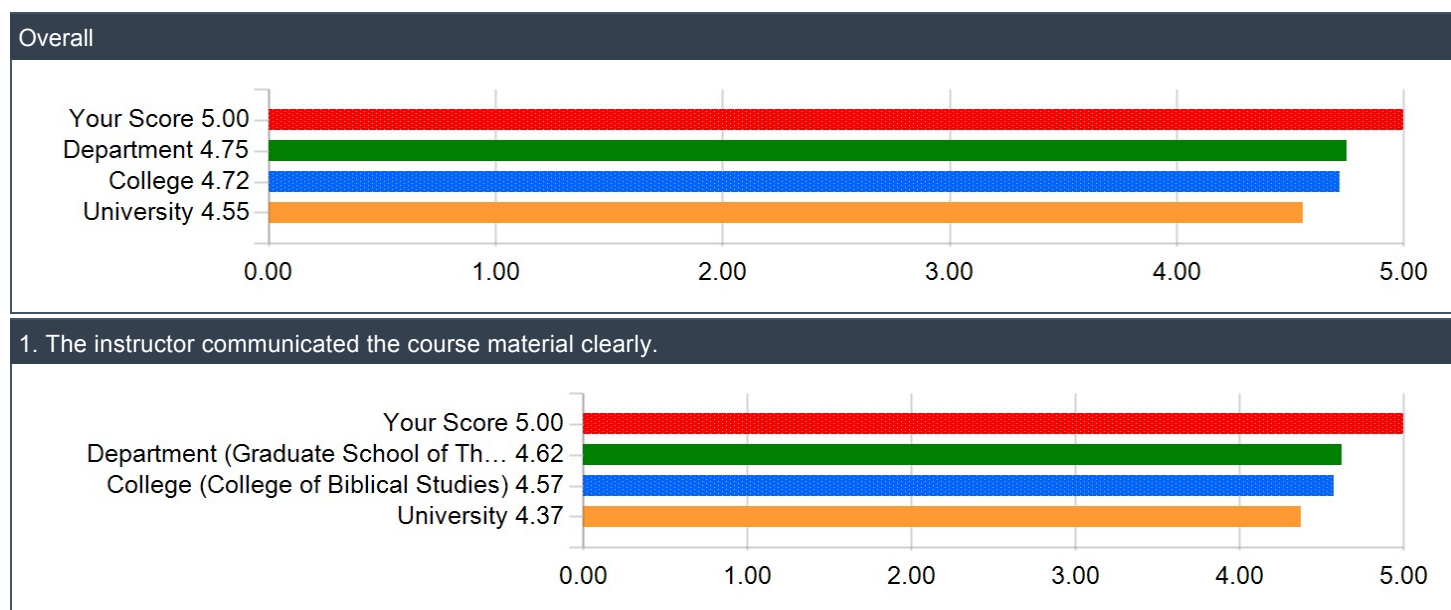

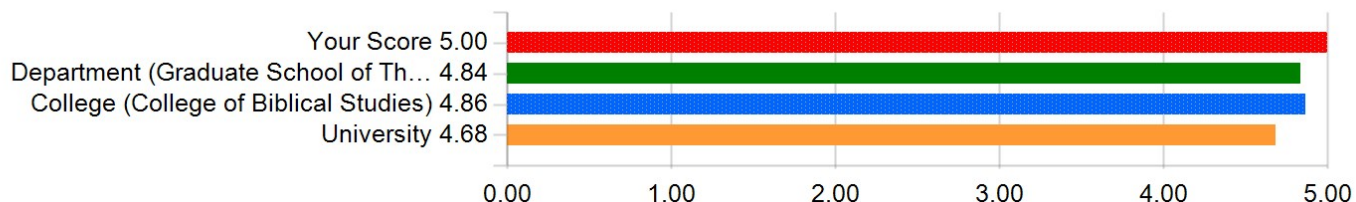
Course Questions: - Comparative Scores



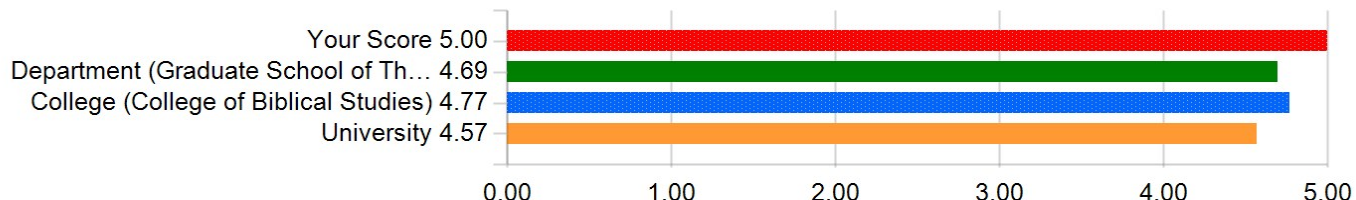

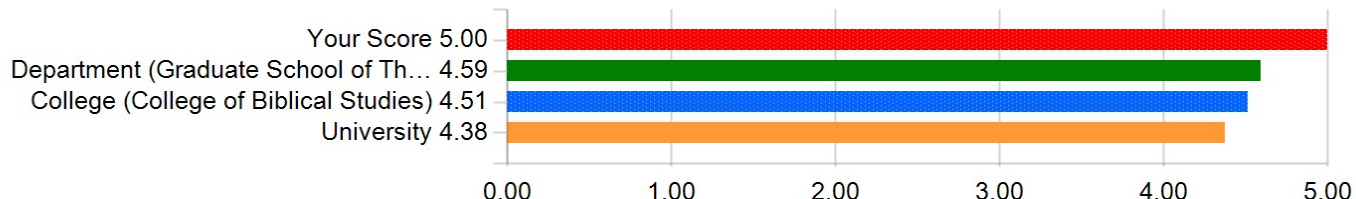

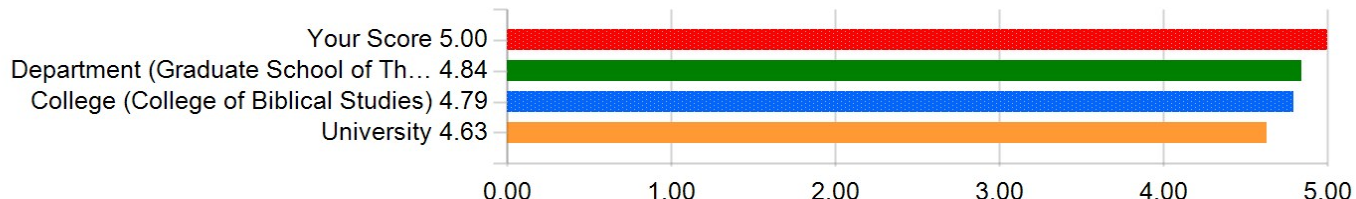
