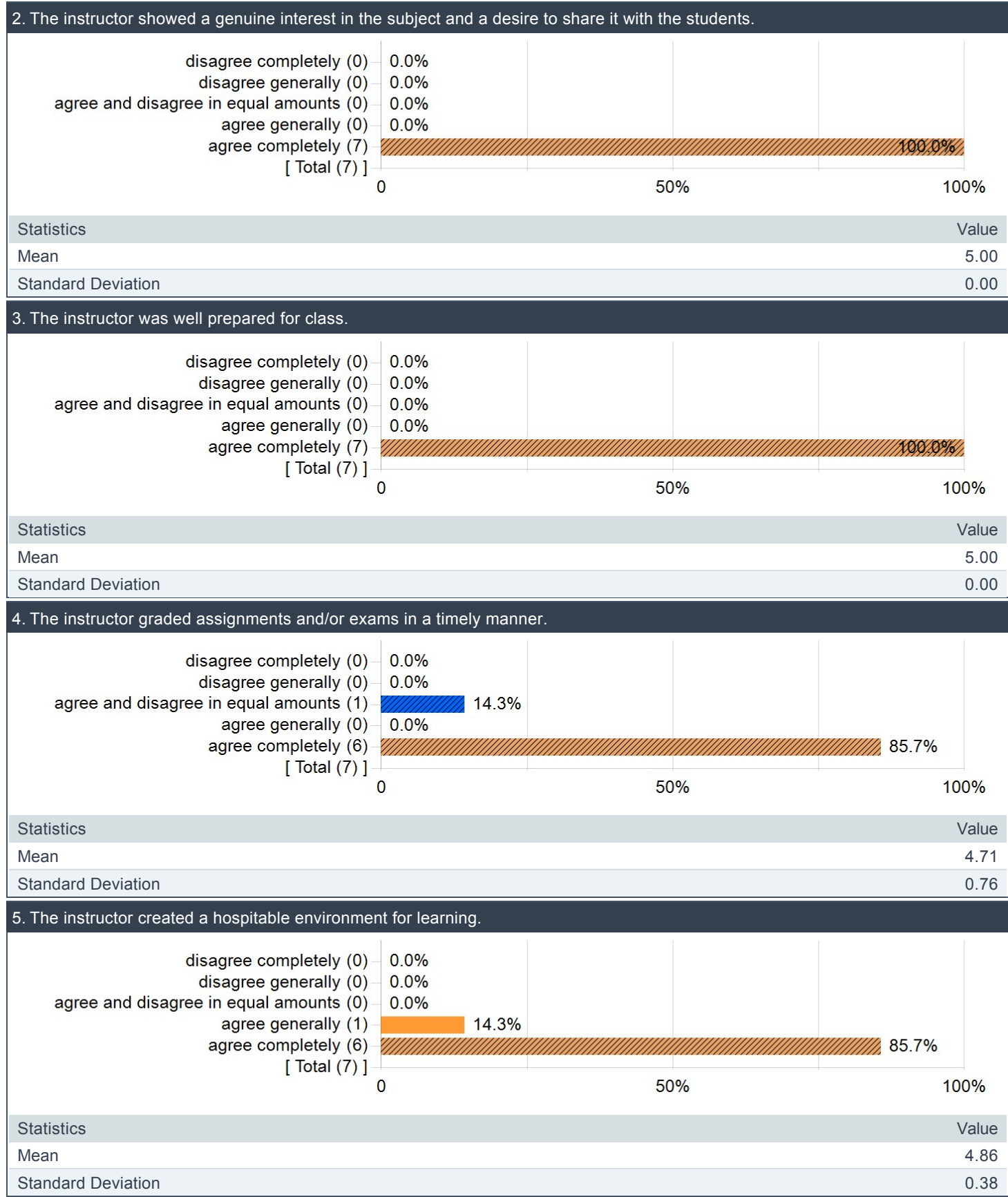

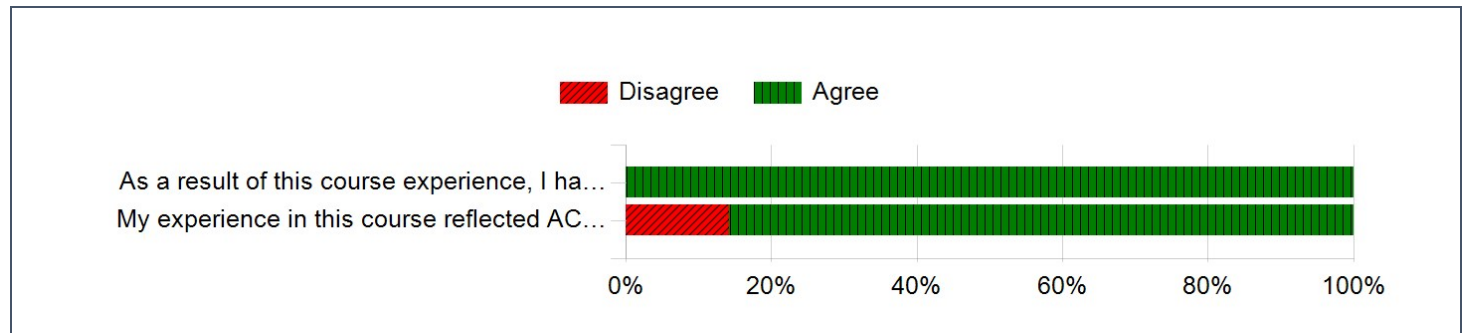

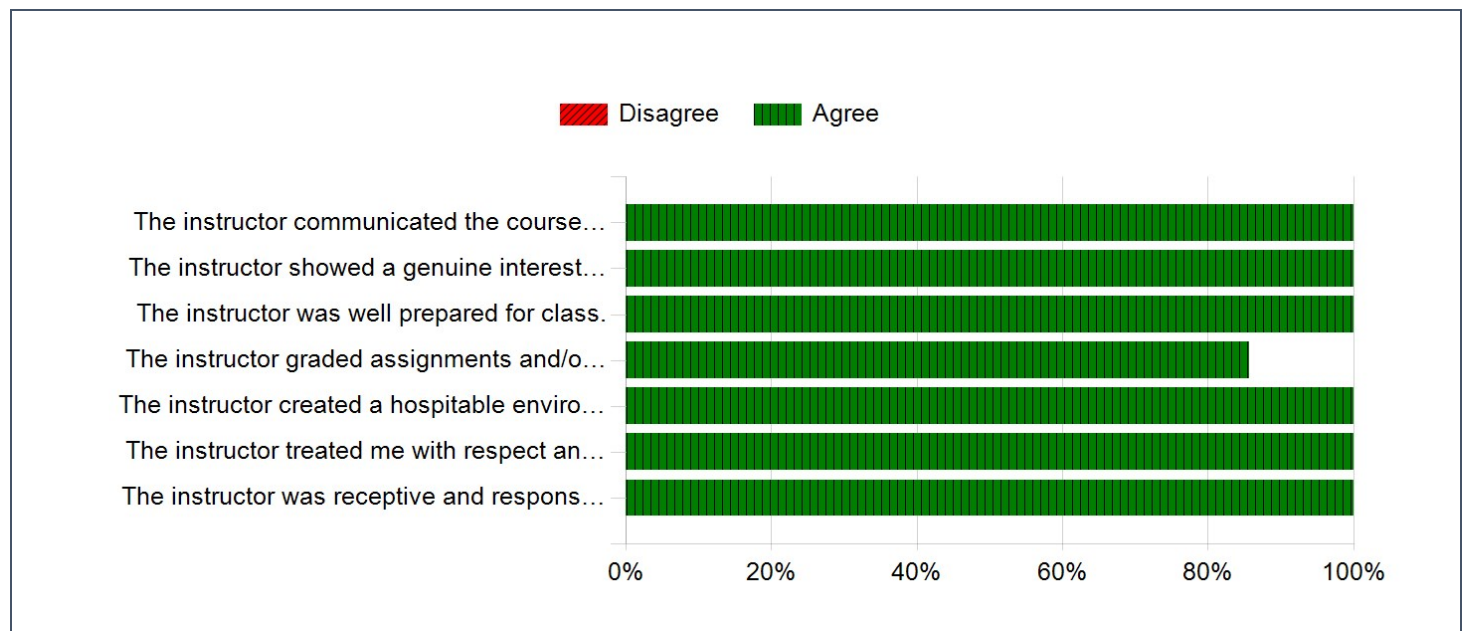
Course Questions: - Aggregate Chart

Instructor Questions: - Aggregate Chart

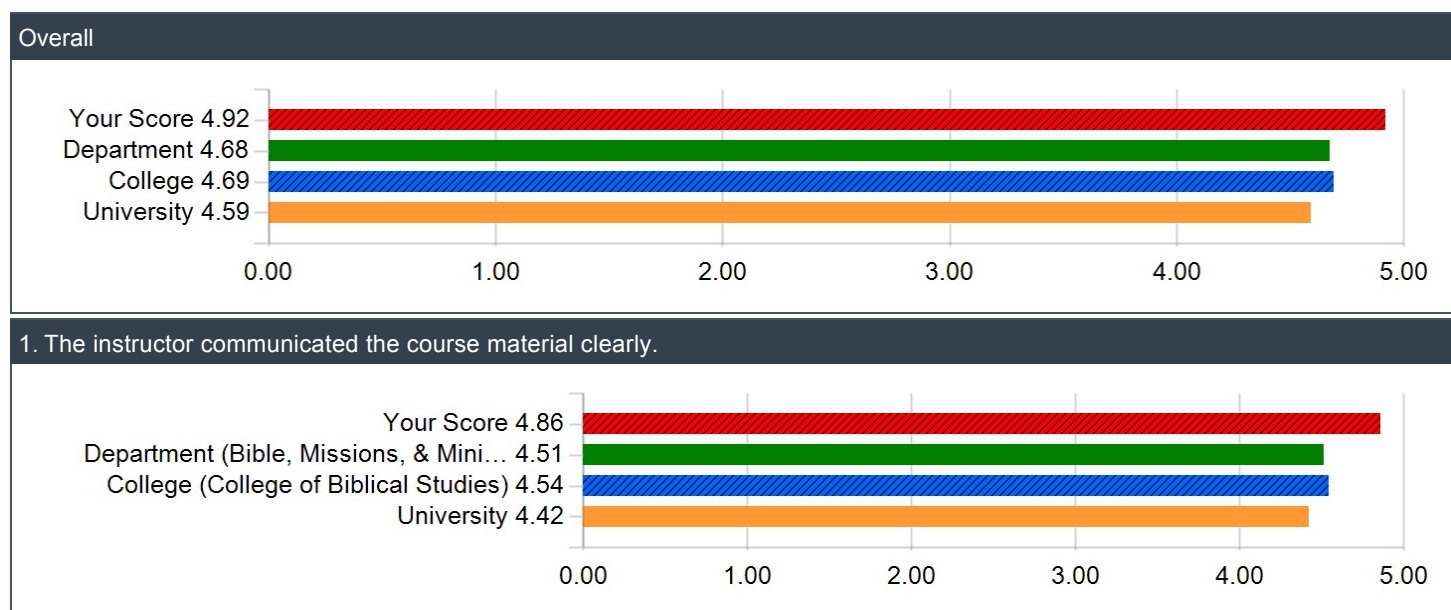
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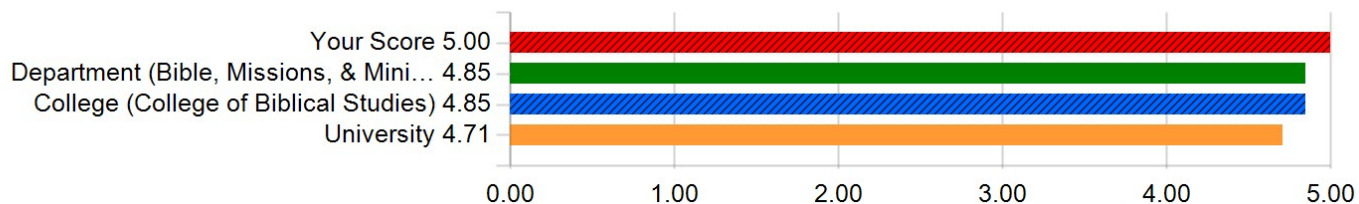
Course Questions: - Comparative Scores



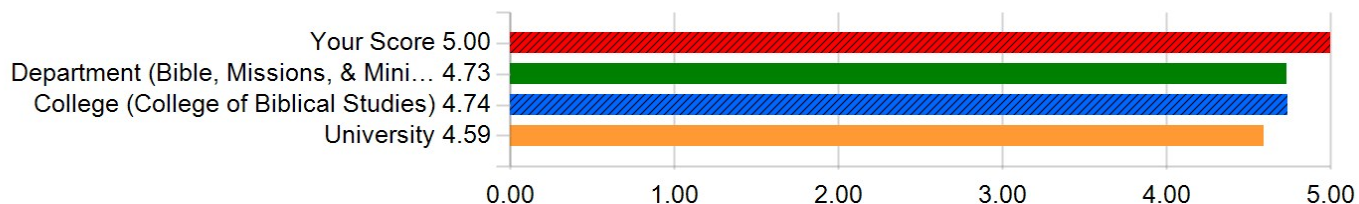

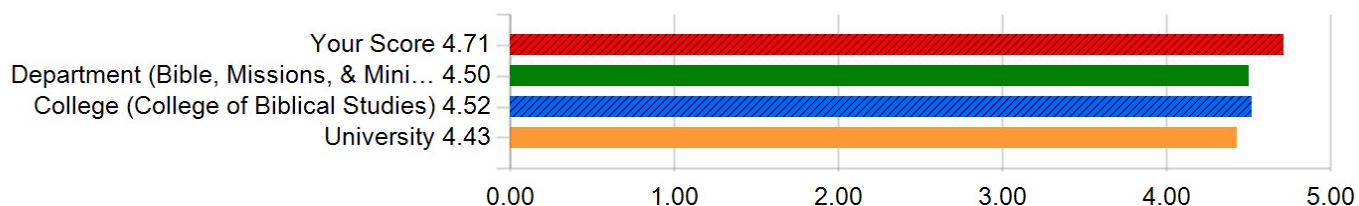

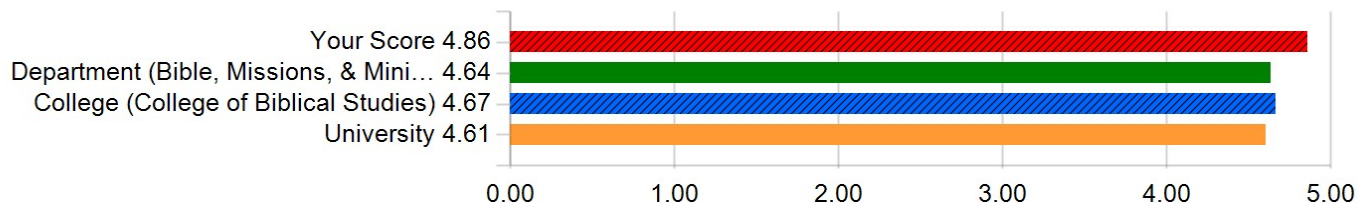

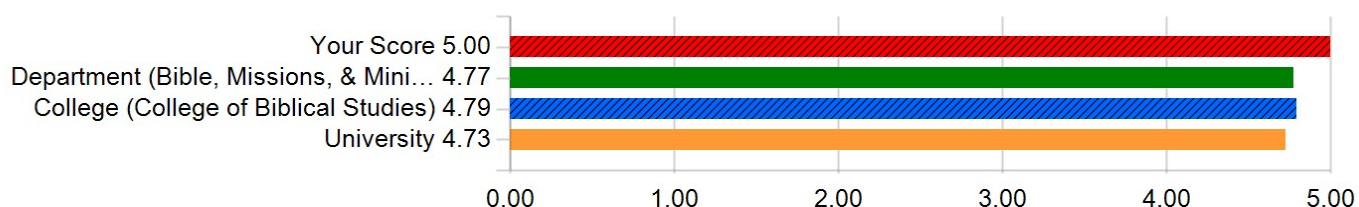

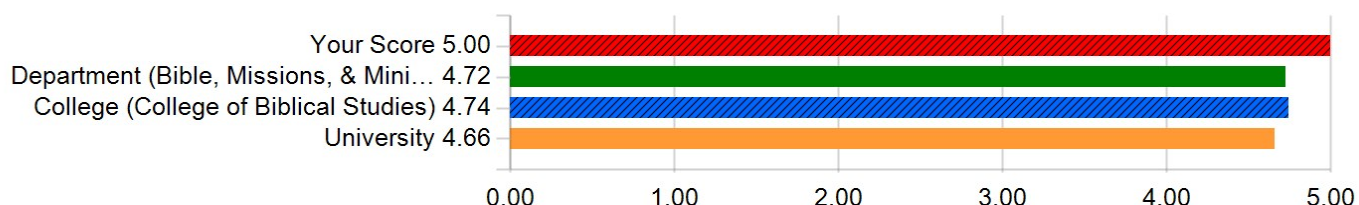

There were two major assignments at the end of the semester, and with the rest of my classes also wrapping up, I found myself so overwhelmed that I just put them off entirely. (I intend to start them as soon as I finish this evaluation.) If there were a way to move one more to the middle of the semester (perhaps make Soul Feast a sort of midterm assignment), then it would be far less overwhelming at the end.
