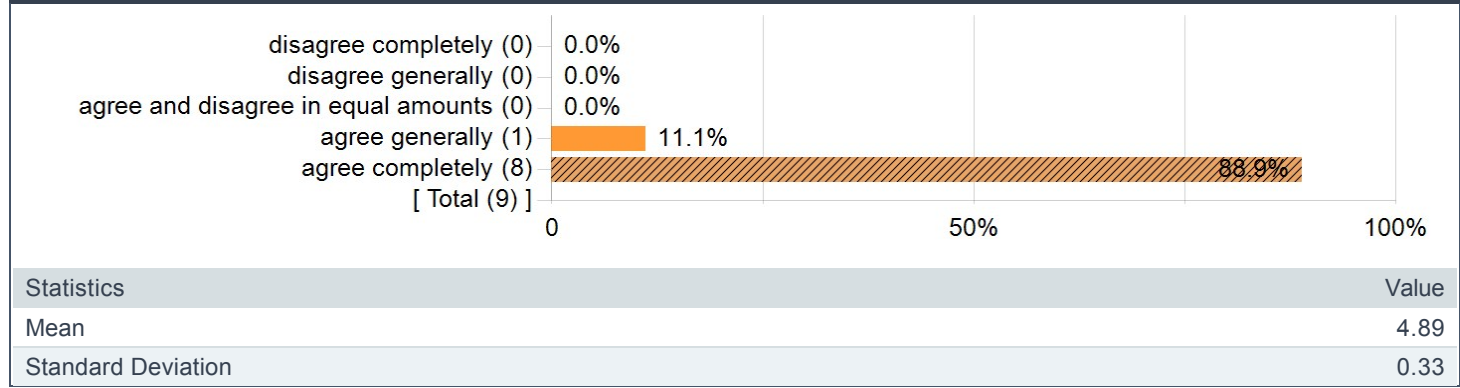

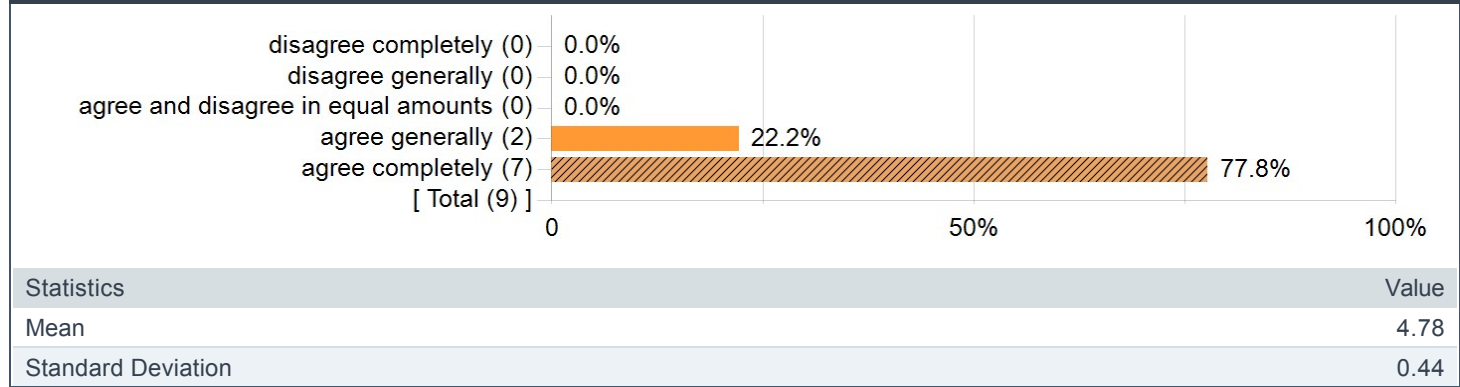

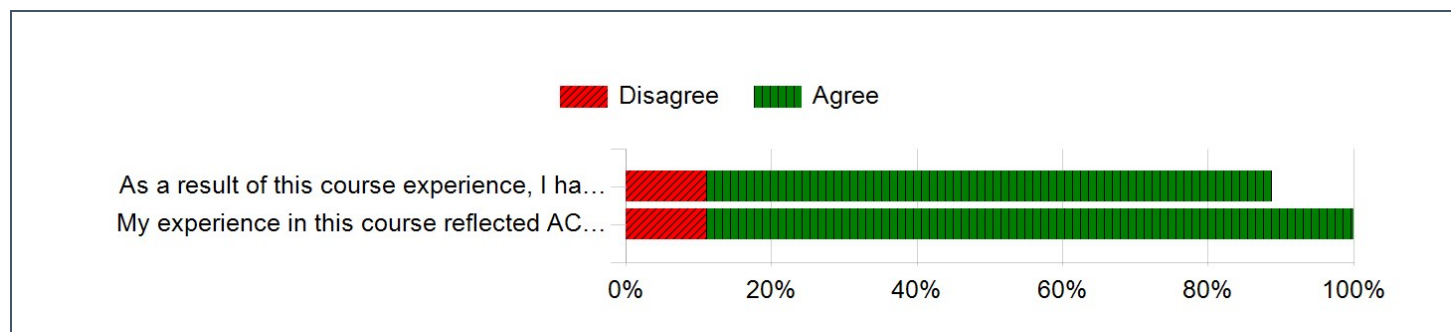

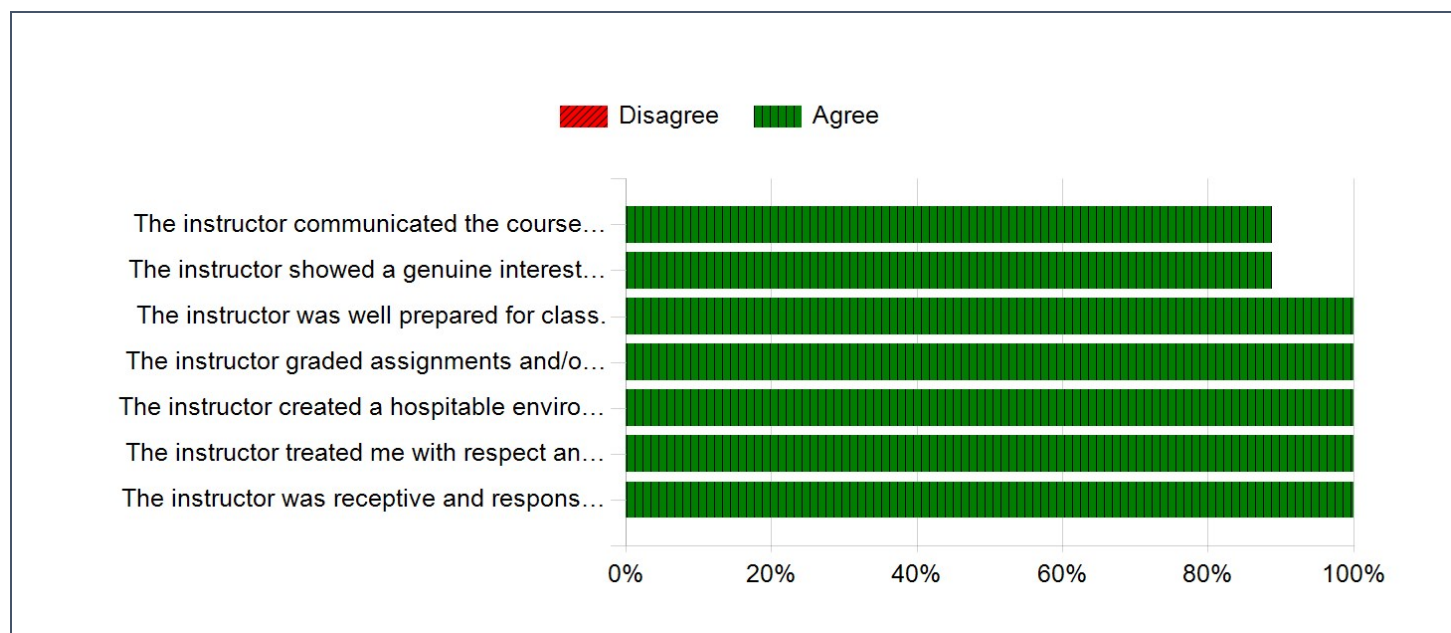
Course Questions: - Aggregate Chart

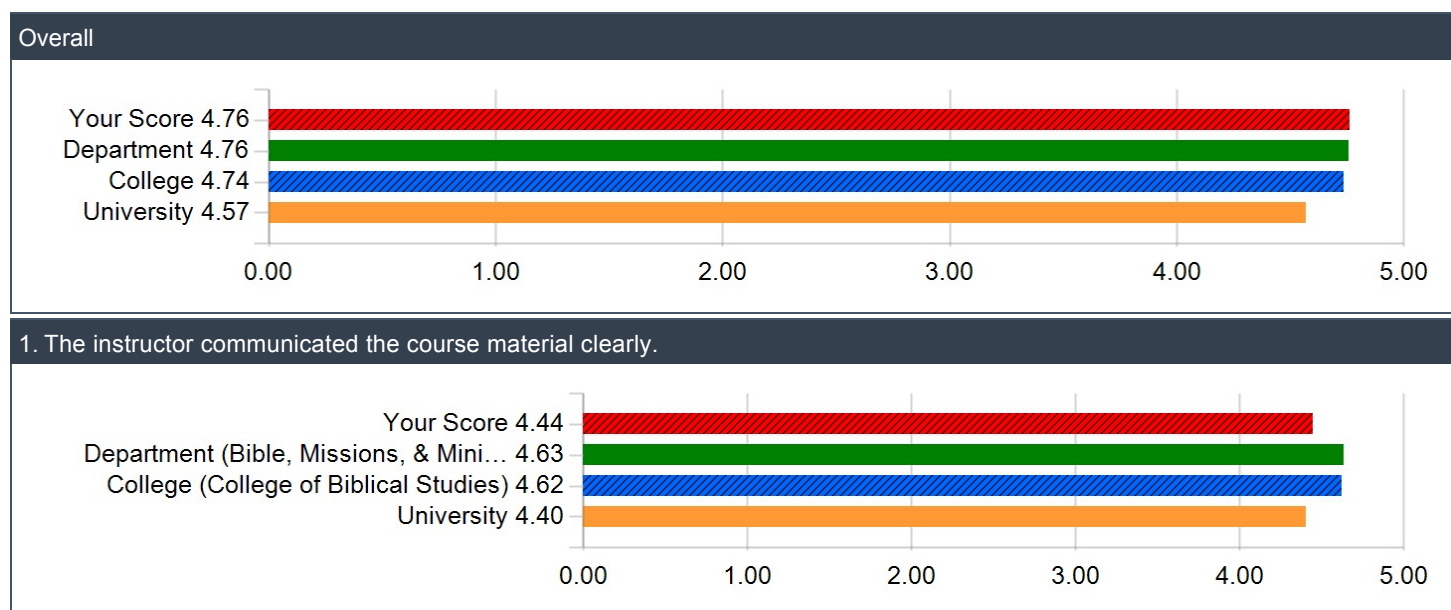

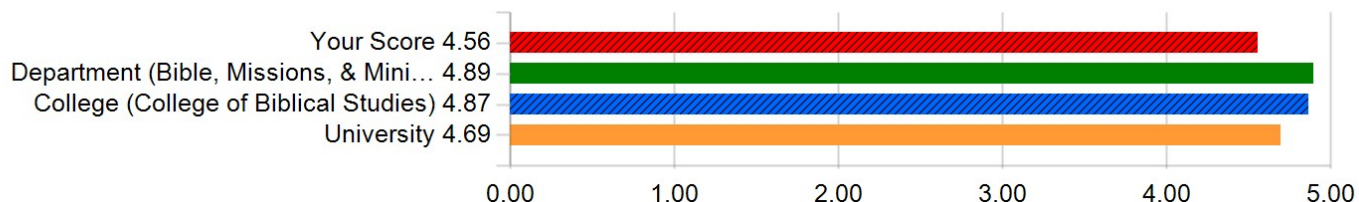
Course Questions: - Comparative Scores



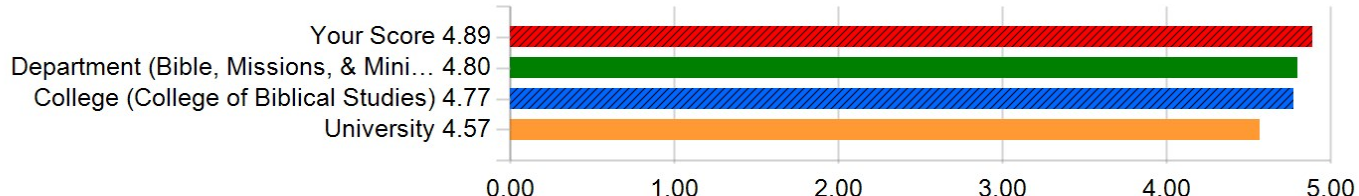
Instructor Questions: - Comparative Scores



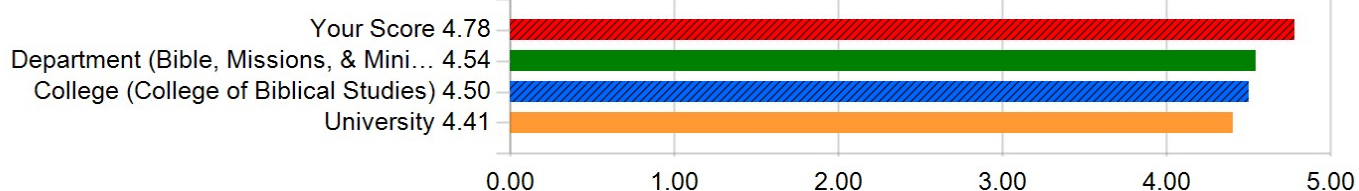

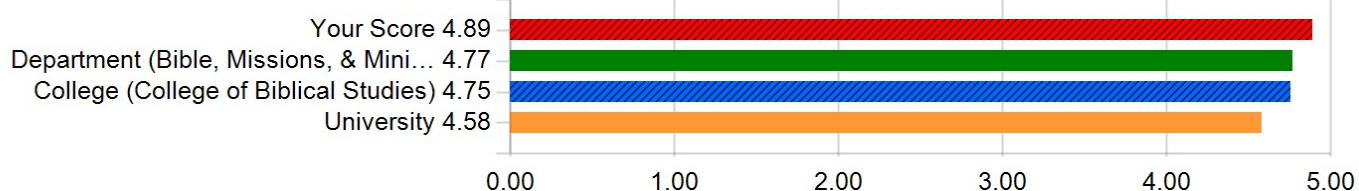

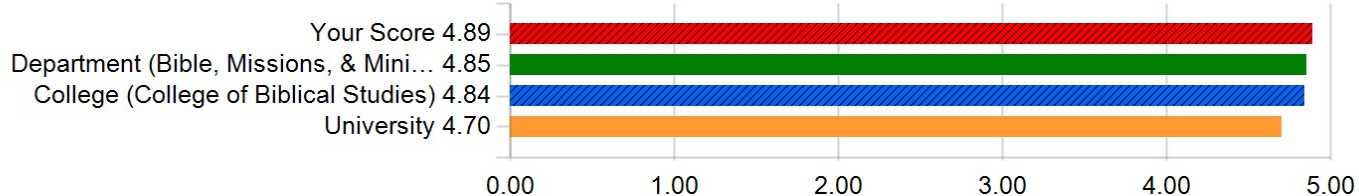

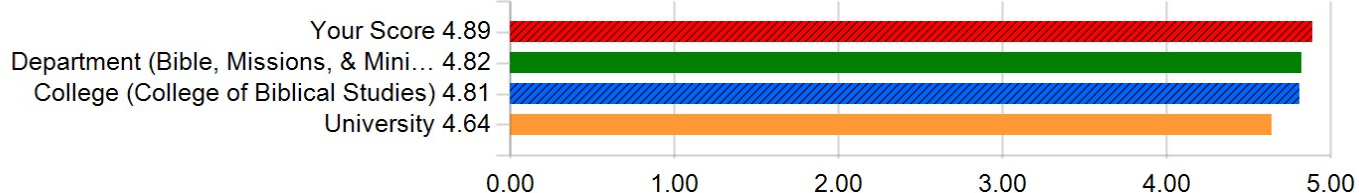

We interacted with new material each week. It was so interesting to explore all of the topics! I loved this class!
I think that reading through the material and reflecting on what you have read and how it applies to the world we live in and our individual lives was beneficial to the betterment of each student and allowed them to open their eyes and see things differently while being more open.
Professor Gibson did a great job with the class. Even though it was completely asynchronous, I still felt invested in and excited about learning this course material. It makes me wish I could've taken the class in person because it would've been even more exciting! I really enjoyed digging into difficult topics like racism and technology and how Christianity and culture are intertwined in those things because even though they were difficult, they made me think. Professor Gibson did a nice job of opening those spaces for honest conversation around topics we don't always love to talk about. I also liked the structure of the class being more about Christianity and how culture formed it in the first half, and then switching to more about culture and how we as Christians can interact with culture in the second half.
I appreciated the freedom allowed within assignments to talk about what mattered most to us within the reading. It allowed for the class to feel more personal, and gave me more individualized insight.

The discussions were super relevant to cultural issues today and addressed a lot of important issues. She also gave space for us to discuss differing opinions and actually cared about them which is rare at ACU and very appreciated.

Having the responses to discussion posts due on Saturday at 11:59pm was tough to remember sometimes, because if anyone responded before midnight on Saturday morning I had to be sure to answer them back by Saturday night. I think this could be improved by having the discussion responses due either Friday at 11:59pm or Saturday at noon. That way, with the 24 hour rule about people commenting on your posts, you only have to be tuned in until Thursday at 11:59pm or Friday at noon to be sure to answer people who responded to your initial post.
I think the class was too writing-intensive. Every single assignment was some sort of writing-based submission, which became very taxing toward the end of the semester. Projects that involve some other type of learning medium would be welcome.
Have more zoom meetings for questions
I think this course was great! I was there was something in Canvas to remind us to reply to discussions on Saturday since I am normally working but otherwise I'd recommend this to anyone.
It was a lot of reading which took a lot of time but nothing other than that.
Change the subject regarding the midterm because it was difficult to understand exactly what the professor wanted. Also, some of the readings were difficult to understand so, I suggest there be other books/chapters to read that are easier to understand. Also for the research paper, let there be less resources regarding the working bibliography therefore, the student can have an easier time looking for academic books. It can be difficult to find 10 academic books when doing the research paper so let it be less.
